WATER BLITZ - split into threes – one to sample the water and set the timer. The others to take the nitrate and phosphate tests. Equipment: water dipper (make in advance), stop watch, paper and pen (or smart phone). *All this is pending the arrival of sufficient sampling kits*.

That will keep 9 people occupied. More people can repair the upper path – need decking board and stakes, possibly bolts to secure board to stakes. There is more woodchip. Watering of transplanted bulbs. Enhance bench views at Lords Lane end. The water samplers can return to Bure Park to join any work done, or start the work if not enough people to have begun it.

VOLUNTEER DAY

Idea so far to keep additional people busy: Can be done in either order, with tea break between.

PHASE 1

Park in Ravenscroft or Avocet (or to minimise cars we should share cars)

Jubilee Lake – sweep/shovel earth and leaves off paths and steps. Little netted corner meant to be for duck nesting – trim back foliage so ducks can easily mount from water's edge. Weave trimmings in netting to make more hidden and block any holes. Perhaps make little shelters or ramps using old pallets.

PHASE 2

Arrange with company near Fresh Direct (Steve knows it) for car parking. Go down footpath and enter wooded area to the left, follow route clockwise and litter pick, over the little bridge cleared earlier, back round to rail crossing, litter picking all the way. Bear right up path to return back to the start.
